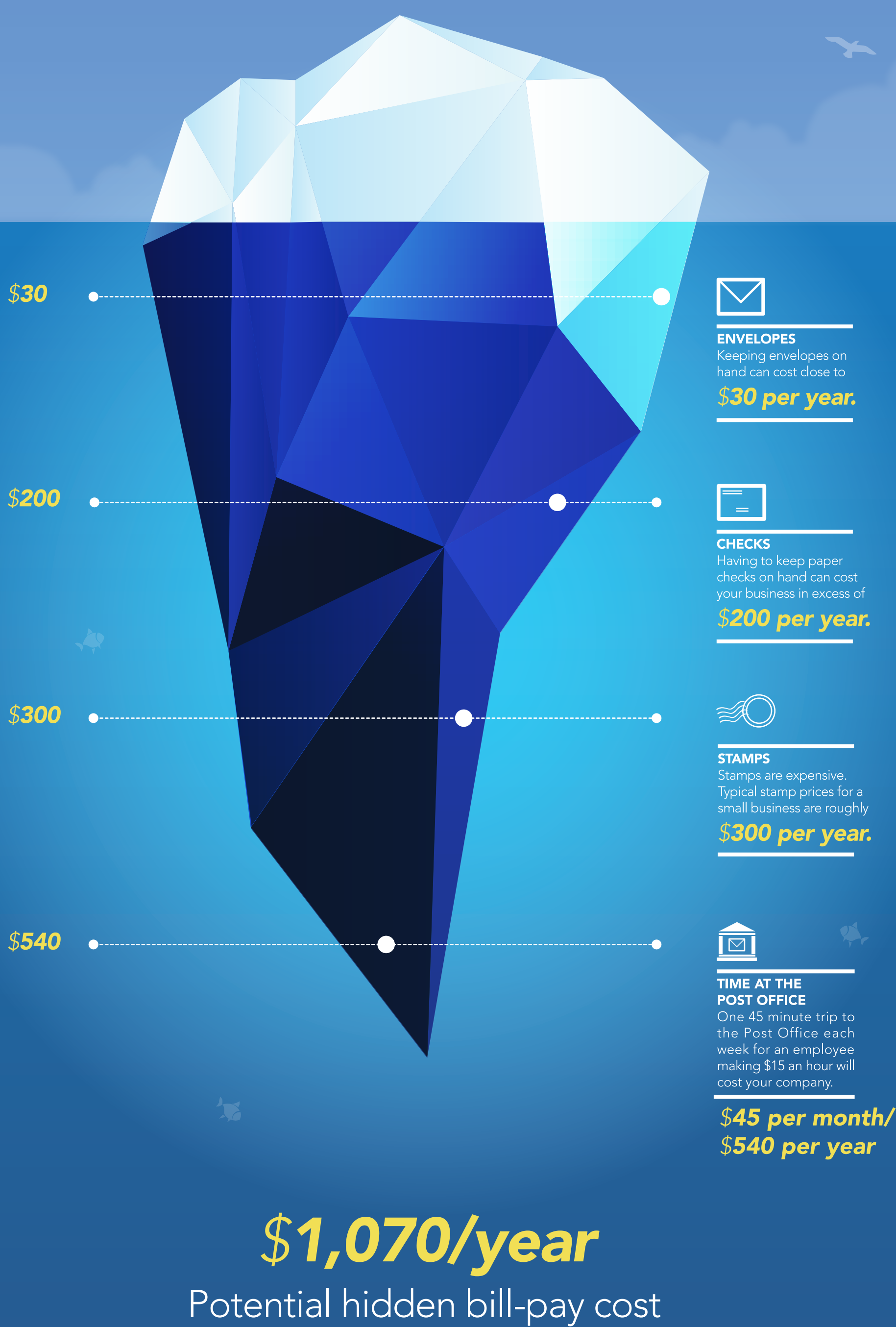
What costs lurk beneath the surface?
